

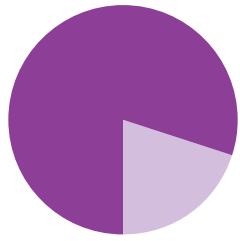


# TDSB Budget Survey Results

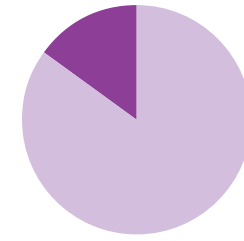
Public input is an important part of the Toronto District School Board (TDSB) budget process. Below are results from the Budget Survey shared with the TDSB community for input and feedback.

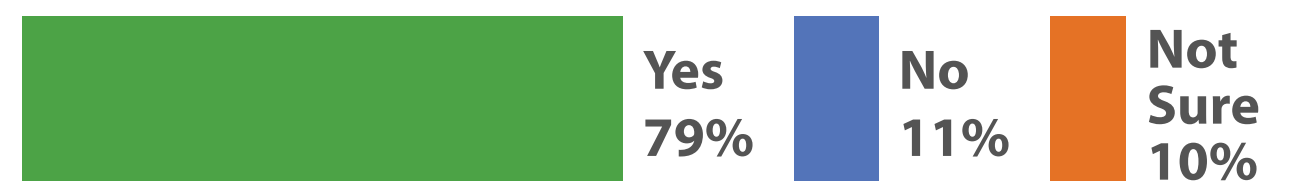
The Board has asked the Ministry of Education to reimburse the \$70.1 million TDSB spent during COVID-19 to implement government and Toronto Public Health directives that were critical to keeping students and staff safe. These funds would eliminate the TDSB's budget deficit and reinvestments could also be made in priority areas. Do you support this request?
