

# Annual Enrolment in Early and Middle French Immersion Programs 2022/2023 and Core French Program 2021/2022

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the report regarding Annual Enrolment in Early and Middle Immersion French Programs 2022/2023 and Core French Program 2021/2022 be received.

### Context

Aligned with the Vision for Learning, the Multi-Year Strategic Plan and the French-as-a Second Language Recommendations, equity of access to Intensive French programs continues to be a key priority.

The Early French Immersion program has been in Toronto schools since the early 1970's. It began in a handful of schools and has grown over the years. At amalgamation, there were 41 Early French Immersion entry sites in the TDSB. In 2009, Operational Procedure PR597 came into effect which allowed for the accommodation of all families who apply by a deadline in an Early French Immersion or Junior Extended French program and outlined a process for program growth. Since 2009, 33 new sites have opened to accommodate growing demand in the program. Similarly, the Junior Extended French program began in 2004 in 7 schools and has since grown to 39 sites. In September 2021, due to recommendations from the French Review, the Middle French Immersion (Grade 4 entry), began in 40 sites, as the Junior Extended French program to serve every residential address in the Toronto District School Board. Core French is mandatory in Ontario from Grades 4 to 8 for all students in

English-language elementary schools. Policy and program requirements for elementary school Core French programs dictate that students entering Grade 4 must receive French instruction in every year from Grade 4 to Grade 8 and must have accumulated a minimum of 600 hours of French instruction by the end of Grade 8. There is one mandatory Core French credit required in Gr. 9.

<u>ENROLMENT</u>: The total number of JK students in 2021 was 14,769 of which 3,107 applied to SK French Immersion and 2,633 accepted (i.e., reserved) placements for September 2022. The percentage of students whose placement was accepted for 2022 was 18% of those in JK in 2021. In comparison, the total number of JK students in 2020 was 14,842 of which 3,089 applied to SK French Immersion and 2,619 accepted (i.e., reserved) placements for September 2021. The percentage of students whose placement was accepted for 2021 was 14,842 of which 3,089 applied to SK French Immersion and 2,619 accepted (i.e., reserved) placements for September 2021. The percentage of students whose placement was accepted for 2021 was 18% of those in JK in 2020.

In addition, of the 2,667 pre-JK student applicants to JK French Immersion, 2,225 accepted (i.e., reserved) placements for September 2022. For September 2022, there are <u>74</u> Early French Immersion sites.

The total number of Grade 3 students in 2021 was 14,481 of which 837 applied to Grade 4 Middle French Immersion and 653 accepted (i.e., reserved) placements for September 2022. The percentage of students whose placement was accepted for 2022 was 5% of those in Grade 3 in 2021. In comparison, the total number of Grade 3 students in 2020 was 14,873 of which 1,064 applied to Grade 4 Middle French Immersion and 834 accepted (i.e., reserved) placements for September 2021. The percentage of students whose placement was accepted for 2021. The for a students whose placement was accepted for 2021. The Grade 3 in 2020 was 14,873 of which 1,064 applied to Grade 4 Middle French Immersion and 834 accepted (i.e., reserved) placements for September 2021. The percentage of students whose placement was accepted for 2021 was 6% of those in Grade 3 in 2020. For September 2022, there are <u>40 Middle French Immersion sites</u>.

To note between 2020 and 2021, the offering at Grade 4 changed from Junior Extended French to Middle French Immersion. The Middle French Immersion and the Junior Extended French programs are qualitatively different programs based on hours of instruction, subjects taught and exposure. Further, the context of the year in which the Middle French Immersion program began (i.e., both application periods unfolded during the pandemic and lockdown periods) makes direct comparisons of application numbers less reliable. Critical to note are further layered and mitigating factors at play during the implementation of the first two years of the Middle French Immersion program, that being declining enrolment, the global pandemic and available programming models such as virtual learning, which may have impacted family decisions.

All on-time applicants (Early French Immersion JK/SK entry for 2022 only and Grade 4 Middle French Immersion) are offered a placement in a program. There are no system wait-lists. While every effort is made to place students in the school identified as their area Early French Immersion or Middle French Immersion school, this is not always possible. In cases where the number of applications in a given area is greater than the number of allotted program spaces in the school, redirection is the process by which applicants are accommodated. Guiding principles for redirection include redirecting

students as a group based on English home school and redirecting to the closest Early French Immersion or Middle French Immersion site with available program space. When a fraction appears in the "Redirection" column of Appendix A, the denominator indicates the number of students who were redirected to a school other than the French program school currently associated to their designated English school as per Operational Procedure PR597 – Early French Immersion/Middle French Immersion. The numerator indicates the number of accepted placements through redirection.

While the tables in appendices for each of the programs show numbers at the entry point, the last table in this report shows the total enrolment in these programs from SK to Grade 12. Please note that, in the attached charts, "*Accepted*" refers to the number of students whose parents/guardians have reserved a placement in the program.

Both Early French Immersion and Middle French Immersion are French-as-a-Second Language (FSL) programs in which French is not only taught as a subject, but also serves as the language of instruction in other subjects.

In a *French Immersion program*, French must be the language of instruction for a minimum of 50 percent of the total instructional time at every grade level of the program.

### Action Plan and Associated Timeline

Staff is committed to increased equity of access to Early French Immersion and will provide a report in Fall 2022 regarding next steps to accomplish this goal.
