RE: ENROLMENT IN FRENCH IMMERSION/EXTENDED FRENCH PROGRAMS 2011/2012

The purpose of this annual report is to provide information on the status of student enrolment in French Immersion and Extended French programs up to June 2011. These programs include Early Immersion, Middle Immersion, Junior Extended and Intermediate Extended. It should be noted that the enrolment situation changes daily depending on parental decisions regarding residence and registration of their children.

In the attached charts, *Registrations* refers to the number of students whose parents have accepted a registration in the program and *Waitlist* refers to the number of on-time, in-district students awaiting admission to a program.
