GENERAL OVERVIEW

Candidates must be available to work 3-5 days per week

Up to 6 hours per day

This position requires travel between TDSB sites on a regular basis. Candidates must be able to move/carry large instruments, chairs, stands, and other equipment for the program, and work additional hours as appropriate for selected activities including school based and system wide events and rehearsals.

Bring your expertise in Band or Strings to support school music programs and instruct students how to play orchestral Band and Strings instruments, namely: piccolo, flute, clarinet, bass clarinet, alto saxophone, tenor saxophone, trumpet, trombone, French horn, baritone, tuba and percussion, violin, viola, cello and bass.

- Arrange, conduct and manage student performances, and may also conduct full orchestra
- Instruction is in a class setting and includes assessment and evaluation of student achievement with feedback to students
- Manage and maintain an inventory of instruments and music
- Design appropriate programs and lesson plans
- Schedule and/or timetable activities
- Make minor repairs to instruments

- The ability to instruct and demonstrate on those instruments
- Knowledge of effective music teaching and learning strategies

- Ability to manage a classroom, resolve conflicts and take appropriate action in emergency situations according to TDSB policies and procedures
