GENERAL OVERVIEW

The Sign Language Facilitator is responsible for facilitating communication between deaf and hearing people. Working in partnerships with deaf and hearing teachers in all subject areas for the purpose of providing equal accessibility to information and may act as an ASL language model and support teacher-based literacy development, and may also interpret for deaf adult staff members.

- Fluently use ASL or English Based Signing (e.g. PSE) with students with a wide range of academic abilities
- be able to use appropriate vocabulary in both ASL and English
- vocalize accurately using appropriate English speech and intention of message as conveyed in the sign message and fingerspell with clarity

- Three year Community College Diploma (English ASL Diploma)
- Two years' experience working with deaf persons of all ages in an educational setting, **or**
Equivalent combination of education and experience
- High level of facilitating between hearing and deaf persons
- Strong knowledge of deaf culture
