GENERAL OVERVIEW

Candidates must be available to work 3-5 days per week
Up to 6 hours and 50 minutes per day between 8:00 am and 4:30 pm

This position supports classroom programs related to food preparation and food safety under the day-to-day direction of Hospitality and Tourism teachers. Candidates must be able to stand/walk for extended periods, and lift boxes, cooking equipment and supplies up to 50 lbs.

- Provide assistance and direction to students in food handling and food preparation techniques
- Assist with the organization and preparation of the kitchen, serving and instruction areas and teaching aids
- Serve food, and/or assist students serving food to customers, staff and/or students
- Assist with catering/sales functions
- Operate and care for kitchen and laundry equipment and maintain sanitation levels in all areas of the kitchen/instruction area
- Operate a cash register and/or collect money for catering
- Check, receive and store food supplies
- Review inventory
