PROGRAM & SCHOOL SERVICES COMMITTEE

The Co-Chairs of Parent Involvement Advisory Committee will be attended the PSSC meeting on Wednesday, January 19th to provide an oral update on the recent activities of PIAC and presented the committee reports for the October, November, and December PIAC meetings. The PIAC co-chairs will be presenting the committee reports for November and December again as well as the committee report for January at the next PSSC meeting on Wednesday, February 20th.

The following are highlights from the January PSSC meeting on January 19th:

A report was presented by staff on the Inclusive Education in the Toronto District School Board. The presentation was informative and offered updates on where the Board is in rolling out inclusive education for various learning profiles. The report also updated the result of research, studies and comparisons of inclusive learning outside of Toronto.

Staff presented an annual report on Before- and After-School Care and Report Back on Full-Day Kindergarten Lunchroom Supervision Study (2017). This report included a study that took place over the last two years discovering the demands and barriers of lunchroom of full-day kindergarten programme and the demands and barriers within the before and after school programming in schools.

A report was presented to the speak to the recommendation of the creation of a new CAC. This recommendation was to create an LGBTQ2S Community Advisory Committee.
