PIAC co-chairs presented the recommendation voted on by PIAC at the April meeting to recommend to the Board that school registration forms include a checkbox to allow parents to consent to the sharing of their email with the school's School Council to facilitate communication and increased engagement by the School Councils with the school community. PIAC requests that this be completed to be included in the 2019 Fall Welcome Packages to parents. Trustees were in favour of the recommendation, at this time the TDSB IT team will be looking into the feasibility of this recommendation and will have a report back to the trustees in early June.
