While we have received over 300+ by-laws and over 300+ Council chair contacts the work continues to confirm whether the information, we have not collected represents that there is no Council or just a lack of reporting of the Council information. As for the 150 Model Schools for Inner City (MSIC), Community Support Workers are working with the school to ensure the establishment of Councils where none exists and nurturing of councils who may be having challenges. For the 23/24 school year, PCCEO will work with superintendents, principals, and Community Support Workers to ensure the creation and effective operation of Councils across the district.
