Budget Town Halls

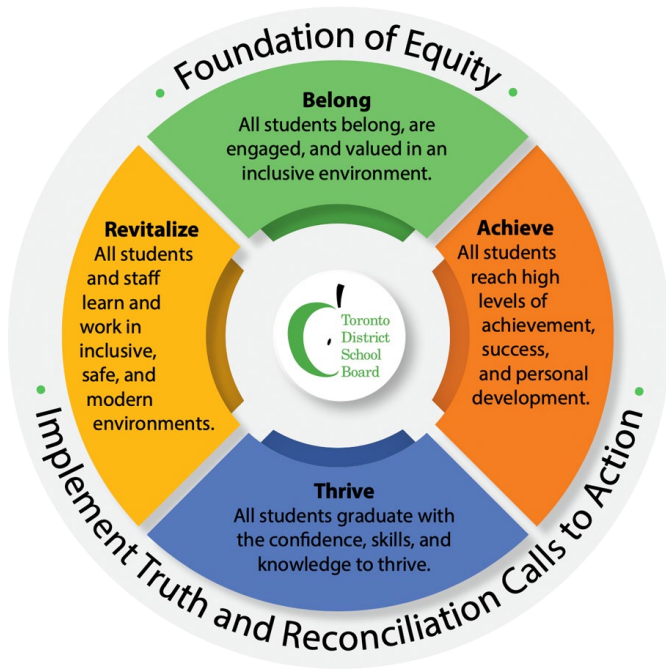
The Board of the TDSB has not yet approved a budget. We have instead decided to defer some reductions in services outside of the core educational components as proposed in the staff report "Options to Balance" and consult with the public.
