Senior Staff Update	Reorganization- Staffing Staff reported that the Board is in a good place with staffing needs in schools this September in comparison with last June. Reorganization process of additional staff allocations are done differently in elementary and secondary panel. The allocation of additional staff will be done on October 3 rd in some elementary schools. Qualified teachers are in place and the roaster for occasional teachers are available for schools.

The Board follows Toronto Public Health for home screening and for schools to be healthy places of learning. Supports for early reading and literacy in English and French Staff to present to PIAC in October on the literacy supports that are available for students. Tutoring Program Ministry of Education announced support and funding for tutoring programs for students K to 12 as part of learning recovery response to the pandemic until December 2022. The tutoring priorities are math literacy and foundational learning skills. The tutoring opportunities took place in spring and summer and over 20,000 students received tutoring through various models such as continuing education, peer tutoring, summer camps, summer tutoring, summer credit courses, summer school, elementary tutoring support and more.
