Director Search Committee

Earlier in the summer the Director for the TDSB, Colleen Russell-Rawlins, communicated to the Board that she was resigning from her position. Her resignation leaves a very difficult hole to fill in the organization and the Board has undertaken a process to fill the position as quickly as possible. The timelines are extremely tight.

Policy Consultation for Personal Mobile Devices

Last school year, before the Province made a separate announcement, the TDSB undertook to explore policy changes around Personal Mobile Devices. This happened in parallel to the TDSB joining a lawsuit against social media companies (https://www.tdsb.on.ca/home/ctl/Details/mid/43823/itemid/267).

The consultation will start in the fall and a report back will generate a more detailed policy than what the MOE has mandated. We will need significant parent input as this policy change will have significant impacts on almost every child and their family.
