	LOI is a TDSB calculation which is formulated by the census, taxation, city of Toronto data (residence and families) and uses that to generate score for schools (socio- economic score)
	 informs board of depts of poverty that schools are surrounded by (income, education, families (single vs two parents)
	5 sets of data go into calculation
	Board uses numbers to determine resource allocation
	primary driver of Model Schools program.
	150 schools with lowest LOI are designated Model Schools (more programing and resources applied)
	10 lowest LOI get an extra VP position

Questions

How has the social deterrence of health come to be a part of what we are focused on along with equity?

 ICCAC moved from primarily looking at Model Schools to looking at a broader picture, looking at everything that affects students from a socio-economic standpoint in order to meet student success

How can ICCAC advise the Board on something that's beyond the Boards mandate?

- ICCAC isn't giving recommendation to the board on socioeconomic status outside the Board
- it's what's the Boards response to how socio-economic factors impact student success

As members what is our role in this and how would we be impacted?

 as we start to build relationship with ICCAC, your role and voice comes from the perspective on what EPCAC brings and how you can merge it with ICCAC

Is there any document that will be prepared regarding the feedback that we can reference to that in what we do?

 document would be the MYSP, we renewed it this year and the pillars have changed a lot from previous version; this is the framework for all CACs to look at to reference and how it would change the focus, and what need do we see ourselves serving within that framework

How do we renew and revitalize our system to better serve students at our schools – business focused?

- revitalize how do we modernize our curriculum delivery
- overarching framework we start with is Equity, and Truth and Reconciliation

Is there a summarized General Audit Report?

- had scheduled audit meeting Dec 4 Auditor general report was released the next day so we couldn't put it on the agenda
- committee members had asked for special meeting

- assume Board will put together a presentation for something like this; will ask if we can share presentation if we have one to be shared with the report
- Trustees had meeting with auditor general; they did not review Spec Ed
- Auditor General indicated spec ed is too big and cannot fit in this engagement

Is there an opportunity to put together a case to get more money?

- audit wasn't released in time to participate in provincial budget sessions, timing wasn't good this year for the budget consultation
- does make a good case for our own budgeting session that starts now and next falls coming engagement

Did you receive the report from transportation department for this school year?

- no, that goes to planning and priorities
- will check with Gary Green about when the information is coming
- know this year it was a lot smoother with the exception of one carrier that had a two-day disruption

When will the new reporting structure be implemented?

don't have a timeline on that

Is there any plan to engage CACs?

don't know, not finalized yet

Is there an intent to create a dashboard to report?

- we have a number of different communications platforms
- Trustees weekly newsletter lots of information that go into there and good communication platform for updates
