

## **Important Information**

- 1. Class size and special education support are the same in Elementary Alternative Schools as they are in regular TDSB elementary schools.
- 2. If a student opts to not continue in a program, they must return to their designated school by primary home address.
- 3. Before- and After-School Programs in the TDSB
  - The TDSB supports fee-based Before-and After-School Programs serving students in Kindergarten to Grade 6 in over 360 elementary schools.

## Important Information (continued)

- 4. Students applying for Elementary Alternative Schools Admissions in JK should also register at their local/designated school by primary home address in case they are not selected at their requested Elementary Alternative School. If selected, the parent/guardian/caregiver must notify their local school.
- 5. Applicants can apply for up to two (2) schools: a PRIMARY school choice and an ALTERNATE school choice. The Alternate choice is optional. A complete list of Elementary Alternative Schools is available on the TDSB's <u>Elementary Alternative Schools webpage</u>.
- 6. The Alternate school choice will only be considered **after all** primary school choice applications have been considered in accordance with our priorities (see section <u>Elementary Alternative Schools Admission Priorities</u>).
- 7. Applicants from outside the TDSB, except for City of Toronto JK applicants, will only be considered after all TDSB applicants have been considered for their Primary and Alternate school choices.





## Important Information to Know Before Applying

- 1. Attend all relevant Open Houses/Information Nights to learn more about the school and their programs. Visit the <u>Elementary School Open Houses and Information Nights</u> webpage for details about the dates and times.
- 2. Learn about each school's educational philosophy and distinct pedagogy. This information will be available on the TDSB and school websites (<u>Elementary Alternative Schools</u>).
- 3. Parents/legal guardians/caregivers requiring support, please contact your child's current school for support.
- 4. If a student wishes **not** to continue in an Elementary Alternative School, they must return to their designated school by primary home address.
- 5. If your child has a physical disability, it is recommended that you contact the Elementary Alternative School you are interested in applying for to ensure that your child's physical needs can be met.
- 6. Transportation is **not** provided.



## **Key Dates**

February 27, 2025	All waitlists will close at 4:00 p.m.
March 4, 2025	* Deadline to accept or decline an offer (by 4:00 p.m.)

<sup>\*</sup>NOTE: If families do not accept or decline their offer on or before the deadline date/time, the offer will be automatically removed. The child will attend their designated school by primary home address



### **Admissions Priorities**

The TDSB will prioritize applicant admissions to elementary alternative schools in the following order:

- Priority 1: First Nations, Métis, or Inuit Peoples
- Priority 2: Applicants who have sibling(s) already at the school and returning in September
- Priority 3: After the placement of Indigenous students and applicants with siblings, 25% of any remaining spaces at every grade in each school will be allocated to applicants who are current TDSB students and self-identify in one or more of the following:
  - Black
  - Ethno-racial group (e.g., East Asian, Latinx, Middle Eastern, South Asian, Southeast Asian)
  - 2SLGBTQIA+ (only for students applying to Grades 7 and 8)
  - Students with a disability

Note for Priority 3: To maintain the minimum 25% of prioritized seats, if a Priority 3 student declines a seat, the first Priority 3 student on the waitlist will be offered this seat in advance of other students



## Admissions Priorities (continued)

- Priority 4: TDSB Priority 3 applicants not not yet placed will be combined with other TDSB applicants for the remaining spaces
- ▶ **Priority 5:** Other applicants whose parents'/legal guardians'/caregivers' primary residence is in the City of Toronto (e.g., from independent/private schools, other school boards, home schooling, etc.) will be considered for placement if spaces are available.
- Priority 6: Applicants whose parents'/legal guardians'/caregivers' primary residence is outside the City of Toronto will be considered for placement if spaces are available



## Important Information for Siblings and Twins/ Multiples

- Sibling Applicants must select their sibling's Elementary Alternative School as the PRIMARY choice
- Application for Additional Students An application must be submitted for each student who
  wishes to enroll at an elementary alternative school.
- Admissions of Twins or Multiples
  - ▶ An application form must be submitted for each child in your family, including twins, triplets, etc. You will have an opportunity to indicate if there are twins/multiple siblings applying for entry to the same school in the same grade.
  - Once you have successfully submitted one application, you will have the opportunity to begin another for another child from the "Submission Confirmation" page.
  - ▶ Please ensure that you indicate on all applications that the applicant has a twin or multiple.
  - ▶ Should a twin, triple, etc. application be selected, both/all applicants will be seated in the class if space is available.
  - If space is not available to seat both twins or all the multiples (e.g., it is the last available seat in the class), the system will randomly select one sibling(s) to be seated. The other sibling(s) will be placed first on the waitlist.
  - If applicants choose to have twins or multiples apply separately (i.e., not indicating that the applicant is a twin, triple, etc.), individual applications will be submitted for each child, and the regular Random Selection Process rules will apply. In other words, if one child is chosen, the twin/multiple(s) is not automatically granted acceptance or waitlisted by virtue of being a twin/multiple.




## The Random Selection Process and Admissions: Reminders

- The random selection process will occur centrally, and all communications will come via email from the Board. Please do not contact schools directly for selection results. Reminder: check your spam and junk emails.
- Friday, February 21, 2025 Round 1 placement offers, and waitlist status will be <u>sent centrally</u>, via email, to all applicants.
- Wednesday, February 26, 2025 Offers must be accepted or declined by 4:00 pm.
  - If you do not accept or decline the offer of placement on or before the February 26, 2025, deadline, the offer will be automatically declined.
  - The child will attend their designated school by primary home address.

## The Random Selection Process and Admissions: Reminders

- Thursday, February 27, 2025 Round 2 placement offers, and waitlist status will be <u>sent centrally</u>, via email, to all applicants. The Waitlist will then be closed and no further offers of placement will be made.
- Tuesday, March 4, 2025 Offers must be accepted or declined by 4:00 pm.
  - If you do not accept or decline the offer of placement on or before the March
     4, 2025, deadline, the offer will be automatically declined.
  - The child will attend their designated school by primary home address.

## Scenario 1: Applicant only applies to their Primary school choice and receives an offer – what happens?



Should the applicant receive an offer for their Primary school choice, the family can accept or decline the offer.

If the applicant decides to decline the offer to the Primary school choice, then they will attend their designated school by primary home address, and no other offer to an elementary alternative school will be provided to the applicant.

## Scenario 2: Applicant only applies to a Primary school choice and does not receive an offer – what happens?



Should the applicant not select an Alternate school choice and does not receive an offer for their Primary school choice, they will be placed on the waitlist for their Primary school choice:

- o If a **seat becomes available** in the Primary school choice, the family will be offered a seat.
- The family can accept or decline the offer.
- If the applicant decides to decline the offer to their Primary school choice,
   then they will attend their designated school by primary home address.
- If a seat does not become available at the completion of the placement process, the applicant is removed from the waitlist.
- The applicant will attend their designated school by primary home address.


## Scenario 3: Applicant applies to their Primary and Alternate school choices. Applicant receives an offer to their Primary school choice – what happens to the Alternate school choice?





- Should the applicant receive an offer for their Primary school choice, the system will automatically remove the applicant from their Alternate choice.
- The family can accept or decline the offer to their Primary school choice.
- If the applicant decides to decline the offer to the Primary school choice, then they will attend their designated school by address, and no other offer to an elementary alternative school will be provided to the applicant.

## Scenario 4: Applicant receives an offer to their Alternate school choice and accepts the Alternate school choice offer – what happens to the Primary school choice?



- Should the applicant receive an offer for their Alternate school choice, the family can accept the offer. If they do, they will remain on the waitlist for their Primary school choice.
- If a seat becomes available in the Primary school choice, the family will be offered a seat in the Primary school choice and automatically removed from the Alternate school choice.

The applicant can then accept the offer to the Primary school choice. If the applicant decides to decline the offer to the Primary school choice, then they will attend their designated school by primary home address, and no other offer to an elementary alternative school will be provided to the applicant.

## Scenario 5: Applicant receives an offer to their Alternate school choice and declines the Alternate school choice offer – what happens to the Primary school choice?





- Should the applicant receive an offer for their Alternate school choice, the family can decline the offer. If they do, they will remain on the waitlist for their Primary school choice.
- If a seat becomes available in the Primary school choice, the family will be offered a seat in the Primary school choice. The applicant can then accept the offer to the Primary school choice.

If the applicant decides to also decline the offer to the Primary school choice, then they will attend their designated school by primary home address, and no other offer to an elementary alternative school will be provided to the applicant.

Scenario 6: Applicant receives an offer to their Alternate school choice and accepts the Alternate school choice offer and wants to be removed from their Primary school choice.

- Should the applicant receive an offer for their Alternate school choice, the family can accept the offer. If they do accept, they will remain on the waitlist for their Primary school choice.
- If the family wishes to be removed from their Primary school choice, they will need to promptly email <a href="mailto:EAS.Application@tdsb.on.ca">EAS.Application@tdsb.on.ca</a> and ask to be removed from their Primary school choice.
- Otherwise, if a seat becomes available in the Primary school choice, the family will be offered a seat in the Primary school choice and automatically removed from the Alternate school choice.
