Re-opening of Toronto District School Board's École Bannockburn Public School: September 2024

Dear Neighbours of Bannockburn Public School,

We are excited to announce the reopening of École Bannockburn Public School, located at 12 Bannockburn Avenue, on September 3, 2024. This newly renovated building will become the Toronto District



School Board's sixth French Immersion Centre with French Immersion classes only.

Beginning in the 2024-2025 school year, there will be classes from Junior Kindergarten to Grade 3. Each year after there will be one grade added so that by September 2027 École Bannockburn Public School will welcome students from Junior Kindergarten to Grade 6.

Improvements of the school building and school grounds are set to be completed mid-August. At this time, furniture will be delivered and assembled and the kindergarten play equipment will be ready for September opening.

In September, we welcome you to enjoy the improved school grounds on the weekends and after 6pm on school days. Please remember, dogs are not allowed at any time.


