

1. What is a Boundary Change Review?

Local neighbourhood schools have attendance areas defined by boundaries that are used to establish admission to a school's regular program. Boundaries between two schools can be changed to reduce overcrowding, utilize surplus space or designate addresses to a closer school.

A Boundary Change Review is one of the strategies included in the Board's Long-Term Program and Accommodation Strategy (LTPAS), a document that was first created in 2014 and is reviewed annually. The strategy provides an approach to program and accommodation planning within a ten-year timeframe that allows for responsiveness and flexibility in a changing environment. It is a roadmap for the future that identifies studies that could lead to Accommodation Reviews.

2. Will my address be affected by this boundary change review?

3. When will the attendance boundary changes take effect?

If approved, the changes to the attendance area boundaries are set to take effect in **September 2026** for new Regular Program students residing at the specified addresses.

There are currently no changes being proposed to the secondary school pathway for French Immersion program students who reside or move to the addresses listed above.

<u>Information for Students Residing within the Shared Humberside</u> <u>CI/York Memorial Secondary Attendance Boundary</u>

4. How will the shared attendance boundary change affect my child <u>currently</u> attending Humberside CI?

There is no effect to students who are currently enrolled in the Regular program and the French Immersion/Extended programs at Humberside CI. Students currently enrolled at Humberside may continue to do so until graduation.

5. I have children who are currently attending intermediate school and will be <u>starting</u> <u>Grade 9 in September 2025</u>. Will they be able to attend Humberside CI?

Yes, they will be able to register at Humberside CI since the boundary change will take effect in September 2026.

6. I have children currently enrolled at Humberside CI, as well as younger children who have not yet started Grade 9. Will the younger children be able to attend Humberside CI?

Yes, younger siblings will be allowed to register at Humberside CI as long as they have an older sibling attending Humberside CI as of September 2026.

7. How will the change to the shared attendance boundary change impact my child who is currently in elementary school and does not have a sibling attending Humberside CI?

As of September 2026, all new Regular program secondary students without an older sibling attending Humberside CI will be designated to York Memorial CI for secondary school.

<u>Information for Students Residing within George Syme CS'</u> <u>intermediate attendance area designated to Humberside CI</u>

8. How will the split attendance boundary change affect my child <u>currently</u> attending Humberside CI?

There is no effect to students who are currently enrolled in the Regular program and the French Immersion/Extended programs at Humberside CI. Students currently enrolled at Humberside may continue to do so until graduation.

9. I have children who are currently attending intermediate school and will be <u>starting</u> <u>Grade 9 in September 2025</u>. Will they be able to attend Humberside CI?

Yes, they will be able to register at Humberside CI since the boundary change will take effect in September 2026.

10. I have children currently enrolled at Humberside CI, as well as younger children who have not yet started Grade 9. Will the younger children be able to attend Humberside CI?

Yes, younger siblings will be allowed to register at Humberside CI as long as they have an older sibling attending Humberside CI as of September 2026.

11. How will the change to the split attendance boundary change impact my child who is currently in elementary school and does not have a sibling attending Humberside CI?

As of September 2026, all new Regular program secondary students without an older sibling attending Humberside CI will be designated to Runnymede CI for secondary school.
