

## **PART-TIME CLEANERS**

**Rate of Pay: \$24.70 - \$26.39 per hour**

Part Time Cleaners will perform cleaning duties including: cleaning classrooms, lifting; climbing; floor cleaning; mopping; servicing washrooms; moving furniture; re-lamping; operating heavy powered cleaning equipment; and grounds cleaning/maintenance including snow/ice removal in accordance with current cleaning standards of the Toronto District School Board. Candidates will also maintain a co-operative working relationship with the Principal, academic and support staff and all other members of the school community.

### **Candidates must possess:**

- Grade 10 or approved equivalent education.
- A good command of written and oral English.
- A proven ability to communicate in a sensitive, courteous and tactful manner with a commitment to customer service.
- A good work record including a record of reliable attendance and punctuality.
- Knowledge of Health and Safety issues relevant to the role of Cleaner.
- Physical ability to perform Cleaner duties.
- A demonstrated commitment to work effectively in an environment which promotes equitable practices and values diversity.

**Shift:** The start time for the shift is anytime between 11:00 AM and 3:00 PM; however the normal start time is 3:00 PM.

**Hours of Work:** 20 hours per week – 12 month work year
